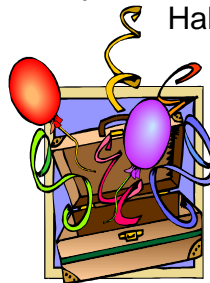
(this is due to a Dalston School Consortium INSET day on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> February).

Please look at the cloakroom noticeboard to keep you upto date.

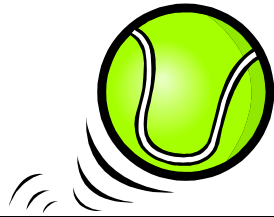
The school will be holding a party and special assembly for Mr
